Nevada Secretary of State Barbara Cegavske

Barbara Cegavske was elected to her first term as Nevada Secretary of State in 2014 and assumed office on January 5, 2015. She was re-elected to her second term this past

November. With more than 37 years of combined public service and small business experience, Cegavske brings a unique blend of business acumen and legislative expertise to the Secretary of State's office.

Cegavske entered public service in 1996 when she was elected to serve in the Nevada Assembly representing Clark County District 5 for three consecutive terms. In 2002, Cegavske ran for and successfully won a state Senate seat for Clark County District 8. She served three full terms before assuming the role of Secretary of State.

In addition to enforcing state and federal election laws and procedures, he oversees the administration of the Help America Vote Act (HAVA). Mr. Thorley has extensive knowledge on a wide range of elections-related topics including campaign finance, military and overseas voting, voter registration, ballot initiatives and referendum, and voting systems. Mr. Thorley began his service with the Secretary of State's office in January 2015 as Deputy Secretary of State for Operations. Mr. Thorley received his undergraduate and graduate degrees in Economics from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas.

As a daughter of small business owners, Cegavske rolled up her sleeves and pitched in with her siblings after school and during summer vacations to help the family business. Her introduction to the free-market system proved to be valuable first-hand knowledge when she and her husband Tim became owners of a 7-Eleven franchise. Over the course of 13 years, the Cegavskes faced daily challenges but also experienced the rewards of employing fellow Nevadans and contributing to the state's economy. Prior to joining the Secretary of State's Office, Mr. Thorley worked for the Nevada Legislative Counsel Bureau for six years where he held a variety of jobs from senior research analyst to fiscal program analyst. He has served a broad range of policy interests, including the Assembly and Senate Committee on Commerce and Labor; the Senate Committee on Energy, Infrastructure and Transportation; the Legislative Commission's Subcommittee to Review the U.S. Department of Labor's Report on the Nevada Occupational Safety and Health Program; the Legislative Committee for the Review and Oversight of the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency and Marlette Lake Water System; and the Task Force on K-12 Public Funding.

Niger Innis is the National Spokesman for the Congress of Racial Equality—a 75 year Old Civil Rights Organization. Niger serves on the Board of the America Conservative Union and the National Black Chamber of Commerce and is also a life member of the NRA and a Board Member of the America Media Institute.

In 2014, Mr. Innis became a candidate seeking the Republican primary designation for Congress in District 4. He won the endorsement of the Nevada GOP State Convention, but narrowly lost a hotly contested race to Congressman, Crescent Hardy. Niger served as a campaign manager for New York's Roy Innis, Mayoral campaign in 1993.

He was hired as one of the first political & social commentators for MSNBC upon its launch in 1996. He has given political commentary for NPR, CNN, BBC, CNBC, FOX, ABC and CBS News. Niger was born and raised in Harlem, New York and attended Georgetown University. He has lived in North Las Vegas since 2008.
